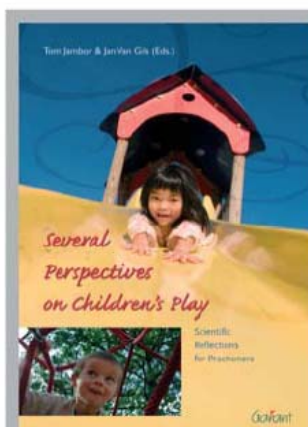




The International Council for Children's Play (ICCP) and the International Play Association (IPA) present:

This panoramic tour of play will be helpful to those teaching and studying within the field of children's play.
